- B. Read your “oath of office” (Article VI, Section 3, of the Constitution of Pennsylvania);
- C. Read all of the messages throughout the Capitol Building: including in the House & Senate Chambers, the Governor’s outer office on the 2nd Floor, the Rotunda, & the Supreme Court;
- D. Read the inscriptions carved in stone on, or near, the Steps of the Pennsylvania Capitol.
